**Corona health concept:**

Following local corona regulations, **you must bring ID and be able to document** – in English – one of the following to enter the Music Hall:

1. a **negative test** less than 72 hours old
2. **that you have been vaccinated**. You document this with the following information: name, DOB, “vaccinated against”, name of vaccine, status of vaccine, date(s) of vaccine
3. **that you have previously been infected** (a positive test at least 14 days old and not more than 8 months old)

Additional information about corona:

- Free rapid antigen corona test are available at the Scandinavian Center right next to the Concert Hall. The results will be ready online in 15 minutes.
- In the Concert Hall **you are required to wear a face mask** except for when seated in “Lille Sal”. **When eating you are required to remain seated**.
- Hand sanitizers are available in all areas.
- The auditorium has a capacity of 365 but is restricted to 165. Every second seat will be blocked during the conference.
- The Concert Hall is a modern building with roomy halls and an advanced ventilation system.
